Material Costs The cost of fiber optic cables varies by type, fiber count, and application. Installation Costs Installation costs depend heavily on whether the fiber is underground, aerial, or indoor. Underground construction is more expensive due to trenching, conduit, and permitting requirements, while aerial installation is generally cheaper. On average, fiber optic network construction costs are approximately \$1,000 to \$1,250 per residential household passed or \$60,000 to \$80,000 per mile of deployed fiber. Commercial building installations with 100–200 network drops typically range from \$15,000 to \$30,000.

Cost Drivers Several factors influence the total cost of fiber optic construction:

- Fiber count and cable construction:** Higher strand counts increase material costs and are often used for backbone routes to allow future expansion.
- Jacket material and environmental rating:** Outdoor or armored cables for harsh environments add 20–50% to costs compared to indoor PVC or LSZH jackets.
- Labor and regional rates:** Skilled labor, local permitting, and project complexity can significantly affect installation costs.
