These metallic elements must be grounded to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, and fire hazards, in accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 770 and NFPA 70 standards. Fully dielectric cables with no metal content do not require grounding. Grounding should be applied at cable entry points, terminations, and any metallic conduit or tray carrying the cable. If metallic members are interrupted by an insulating joint or equivalent device, grounding may not be necessary even when exposed to power conductors. Always consult the cable datasheet or jacket markings to confirm the presence of metallic elements before installation. Fiber optic markers are available in various forms, including self-laminating tags, hang tags, labels, and snap-on markers. These markers are brightly colored, customizable, and designed to remain readable over time. They can be tied with nylon ties or attached to conduits to clearly indicate the presence of fiber optic cables. Marking is particularly important in outside plant (OSP) networks, where unmarked cables can be accidentally damaged during excavation or maintenance.
