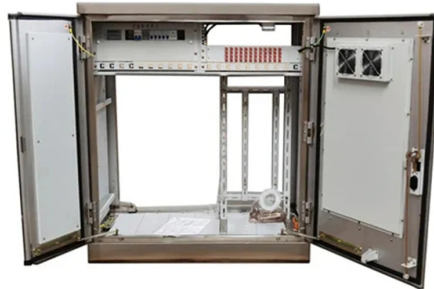

- Tension Limits:** Always check the manufacturer's specifications for maximum tensile load. Exceeding this limit can snap internal fibers or damage the cable. Use tension monitoring devices, breakaway pull swivels, or hydraulic/electronic pullers to control force during installation ().
- Pulling Tools:** For pre-terminated or multi-strand cables, use specialized pulling eyes or mesh grips that distribute tension evenly across the strength member. Tools like the Cleerline SSF-PULLEYED or SSF-PULLEYEM are designed to reduce twisting and secure the cable during the pull ().
- Conduit and Well Considerations:** Evaluate conduit fill ratio, sidewall pressure, and potential jamming points. Ensure all conduit edges and bends are smooth to avoid crushing the cable. Maintain sidewall pressures below the crush load acceptance criteria defined for indoor/outdoor cables ().
- Safety Precautions:** Wear safety glasses to protect against fiber shards, and avoid excessive bending, pulling, or crushing. Record cable identification markings and follow local company practices for installation ().

Inspect and Prepare Cable: Remove a small portion of the jacket to expose the strength member. Loop it into a pulling eye and secure with ta...
