Their Atritor Cell Mill processes complex cable materials, providing high throughput, minimal wear, and controllable particle size. This allows damaged or short-length fiber optic cables to be converted into reusable particles or materials, supporting circular economy goals and reducing landfill disposal . Corning has implemented a commercial recycling process for scrap optical-fiber cable. Their method separates the cable into plastic, metal, and optical-fiber glass, with the glass potentially reused as substrate and the plastic re-ground, re-melted, and resold. This approach achieves near-zero landfill waste and demonstrates a scalable model for fiber optic particle recycling . The Climate Change Company and Littar have explored converting fiber optic waste into Littar®, a material derived from non-recyclable fiber scrap, providing an eco-friendly reuse pathway for materials that would otherwise be incinerated or landfilled .
