

Fiber Optic Cable Well Grounding

Key Principles Fiber optic cables transmit data as light through glass or plastic fibers, meaning the fiber core is non-conductive and does not require grounding. These components must be grounded to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, and fire hazards. Fully dielectric cables with no metal content do not require electrical grounding.

When Grounding is Required Grounding is necessary in the following scenarios:

- Metallic members in the cable:** Any metallic strength member, armor, or messenger wire must be bonded and grounded according to applicable codes.
- Metallic conduits or trays:** Even if the cable itself is dielectric, any metallic conduit or tray carrying fiber optic cables must be grounded under standard electrical codes.
- Exposure to power conductors:** If metallic members of the fiber optic cable are exposed to contact with electric light or power conductors, grounding or interruption with an insulating joint is required as close as practicable to the point of entry or termination.

Grounding Standards and Codes NEC (National Electrical Code) Article 770 and NFPA 70 provide binding requirements for grounding optical fiber cables. IEEE and TIA standards offer additional guidance for bonding and grounding in commercial and industrial installations.

Indoor installations: Follow AE Note 140 and NEC guidelines for bonding fiber optic hardware and conductive cables within buildings.

Armored cables: Interlocking or corrugated armored cables require bonding and grounding, whereas dielectric-armored cables can provide protection without grounding.
