 - Clamps and Straps:** Secure incoming and outgoing cables to prevent strain on splices.
 - Storage Loops:** Hold excess fiber length for future re-splicing or network changes.
- Mounting Hardware** Terminal boxes can be wall-mounted, rack-mounted, or desktop-installed. Accessories include brackets, screws, and rubber grommets to secure the box and protect cables at entry points.
- Environmental Protection Components** For outdoor installations, accessories such as rubber diaphragms, sealing gaskets, and weatherproof covers protect fibers from moisture, dust, and temperature variations.
