Connect each router to a separate port on the switch. Configure point-to-point links and routing so that each router can manage its own subnet while sharing the fiber connection.

Direct Connection Considerations
Directly connecting two routers to the ONT is generally not recommended unless the ISP allows multiple IPs. Without proper configuration, both routers may compete for the single public IP, causing connectivity issues.

Best Practices
Place the primary router centrally for optimal coverage. Ensure the secondary router supports the same frequency bands to prevent interference. Use h...
