

Fiber optic cable paired with router



AI Overview

To connect a fiber optic cable to your router, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal, then link it to your router via an Ethernet cable.

Required Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Provided by your ISP, this device converts the incoming fiber optic light signal into an electrical signal your router can use.
- Fiber optic cable:** Usually thin and flexible, with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors, supplied by your ISP.
- Router:** Ensure it has a WAN or Internet port compatible with Ethernet input from the ONT.
- Ethernet cable:** Cat6 or Cat6a recommended for high-speed data transfer between the ONT and router.
- Power cables:** For both the ONT and router.

Step-by-Step Connection

Install the ONT: Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall to the ONT's optical port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2-5 minutes.

Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN or Ethernet output port to the router's WAN or Internet port.

Power on the Router: Plug in the router and wait for it to boot. Confirm the connection via the router's indicator lights.

Configure Router Settings: Access the router's web interface (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to set up your Wi-Fi network, change default credentials, and enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for prioritizing traffic.

Verify Connection: Run a speed test or connect a device directly to the ONT to ensure the fiber signal is properly converted and transmitted.

Tips for Optimal Setup

- Handle fiber connectors carefully:** Avoid touching the fiber tip to prevent damage or signal loss.
- Placement:** Keep the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally with surge protection.
- Cable quality:** Use high-quality Ethernet cables to maintain the full speed potential of your fiber connection.
