These devices report data to the monitoring software for real-time analysis ().**Optical Switches (OSW):** Use optical switches to route signals from multiple fiber strands to the monitoring devices without disrupting network traffic ().

Step 4: Configure Network Management SoftwareInstall the monitoring software on a server or workstation. Configure it to:
• Receive data from OTDR and OPD devices.
• Monitor fiber performance metrics such as link loss, attenuation, and optical signal-to-noise ratio (OSNR).
• Generate alerts via email, SMS, or phone calls when anomalies are detected ().
• Maintain digital records of fiber construction, splicing, and maintenance activities f...
