ODFs are available in 24, 36, 48, 72, 96, and 144+ core configurations. It is recommended to match the current fiber count plus a 30-50% buffer to accommodate future network expansion.

High-density deployments, such as data centers or 5G base stations, may require ODFs with 144 cores or more to handle large-scale fiber connectivity.

Additional Considerations

Fiber Type: Single-mode or multi-mode fibers should be specified based on network requirements.

Environmental Compliance: For regions like Europe, sustainable materials and compliance with electronics recycling regulations may be required.
