

Fiber optic fusion splicer and fiber optic cable length



Overview

Fusion splicers are used to create long cable lengths by splicing multiple cable segments. Since OTDRs have directional errors, testing may be required from both. Fusion splicing is the process of fusing or welding two fibers together usually by an electric arc. There are several instances where this may be necessary including, repairing a damaged fibre cable, extending a fibre cable link or installing a new fibre tray or IANOS Splice Module where the installation fibres need to be.
