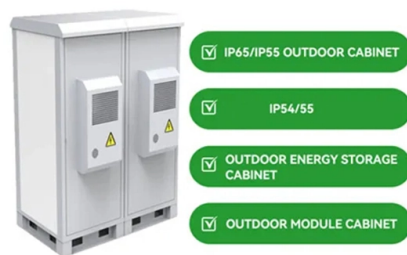


Fiber optic patch cords affect optical module power
