

Fiber optic switch cannot connect to signal

Also, confirm that both ends of the link support the same speed (e.g., 1G, 10G) and duplex settings.

Step 3: Check Fiber Polarity Fiber links are full-duplex, requiring the transmit (Tx) on one end to connect to the receive (Rx) on the other. If Tx is connected to Tx or Rx to Rx, the link will remain dead. Flipping one end of the duplex cable usually resolves polarity issues.

Step 4: Test Signal Strength Use an optical power meter or OTDR to measure signal loss. Values outside the typical range (e.g., -15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate problems with the fiber or connectors. Consistent signal degradation may suggest bending, dirty endfaces, or aging components.

Step 5: Swap or Inspect Transceivers If the physical layer is intact, swap the SFP/SFP+ modules with known-good units to rule out hardware failure. Look for symptoms like "module not detected" errors, link instability, or higher-than-normal power consumption, which indicate transceiver issues.
