Orientation and Installation Considerations Steel cable trays can be installed in horizontal or vertical orientations, but the manufacturer's guidelines must be followed, especially for non-standard "edge-wise" installations. Proper orientation minimizes dust accumulation and ensures cable stability. Load and Fill Compliance Do not exceed the maximum allowable fill or weight specified by the manufacturer and NEC Sections 392.8-392.12. Overfilling can lead to tray deformation, cable damage, or structural failure. A general guideline is to fill trays to 40-50% of their internal area for safe operation. Grounding and Bonding Steel trays must be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards. Use bonding jumpers or grounding lugs as specified in Section 26.05.26 of standard installation guides. Ensure continuity across tray sections and connections. Maintenance and Inspection After installation, inspect all supports, fasteners, and tray alignment periodically. Tighten loose bolts, replace corroded components, and verify that cabl...
