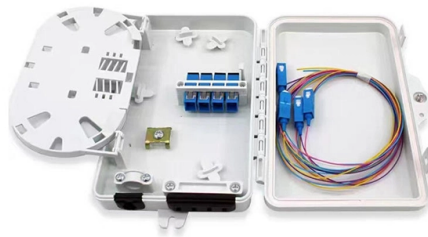


General-purpose fiber optic cable for networks



AI Overview

General-purpose fiber optic cables provide high-speed, long-distance, and interference-resistant connectivity for modern network infrastructures. Overview Fiber optic cables transmit data using pulses of light through glass or plastic fibers, offering higher bandwidth, longer transmission distances, and immunity to electromagnetic interference (EMI) compared to copper cables (). They are widely used in data centers, enterprise LANs, telecom backbones, and industrial networks to support data rates from 1 Gbps up to 400 Gbps and beyond ().

Types of Fiber Optic Cables

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)
 - Core diameter: ~9 microns
 - Supports long-distance, high-speed transmission (up to 25 miles without repeaters)
 - Ideal for backbone networks, telecom, and long-haul links ()
- Multimode Fiber (MMF)
 - Core diameter: 50-62.5 microns
 - Supports shorter distances (typically up to 984 ft for 10 Gbps)
 - Common in data centers, enterprise LANs, and campus networks ()
- Specialty Cables
 - Armored fiber: Reinforced for protection against crushing, bending, and rodents
 - Industrial fiber: Resistant to vibration, oil, chemicals, and extreme temperatures
 - High-density cables: LC uniboot designs reduce bulk and improve airflow in racks ()

Cable Construction

- Core: Glass or plastic fiber that carries light
- Cladding: Reflects light back into the core
- Primary coating: Protects the fiber from bending and physical damage
- Strength members: Kevlar or steel for tensile strength
- Outer jacket: Flame-retardant, UV-resistant, or marine-grade depending on environment ()

Connectors and Terminations

Common connectors include LC, SC, ST, MPO/MTP, and CS, which are chosen based on space constraints, bandwidth requirements, and environmental conditions (). Pre-terminated solutions like Active Optical Cables (AOC) and Direct Attach Cables (DAC) simplify installation and reduce deployment time ().
