

Ground wire on the distribution box

Additional Considerations

- Wire Sizing:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is common, while other markets may require 6 mm². For subpanels, ensure the ground wire is separate from the neutral to prevent current on the grounding path.
- Grounding Electrode:** The PE bar should be connected to a grounding electrode, such as a ground rod, to provide a path to earth for fault currents.
- Safety Precautions:** Ensure all connections are tight, clearly marked, and inspected regularly. Avoid bonding neutral and ground in subpanels to prevent shock hazards and ensure proper breaker operation.

By following these steps, the distribution box and all connected devices will have a reliable grounding system, protecting both equipment and personnel from electrical faults.

How To Ground The Distribution Box

The metal box itself should be processed with a "box grounding bolt" (with PE mark), which must be connected to the grounded PE bus with a copper core wire or a special braided soft wire;

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
