Surge Protection Devices (SPD) are recommended for lightning protection.
- Planning and “Ways”** Ways: Each slot in a distribution box is called a “way.” A 12-way box has 12 slots, but some are reserved for the main switch and protection devices. Proper planning ensures enough spare ways for future expansion, such as EV chargers or solar panels.
- Load Calculation:** Count all circuits and add 30% spare capacity to accommodate future needs.
- Grouping Strategy:** Group circuits logically by function and location to simplify troubleshooting and maintenance. For example:
 - Lighting: 2–3 circuits for different floors or zones
 - Sockets: 1–2 circuits per floor
 - High-power appliances: 1 circuit per appliance
