Enclosures should allow easy access for maintenance and accommodate guest room controllers for lighting, HVAC, and shading systems
- Integration with Room Management Systems** Guest Room Management Systems (GRMS) control lighting, HVAC, and shading, often using dedicated controllers per room. Electrical loads can be automatically switched on/off via key card systems to save energy. Wiring accessories (switches, sockets, data outlets) should be uniform and compatible with the GRMS
- Wiring and Conduit Standards** Use rigid steel, EMT, or IMC conduits, with galvanized steel for exposed areas. Copper conductors are standard; MC or AC cables may be used where permitted. Avoid sharing circuits between guest rooms to maintain safety and load integrity
- Safety and Compliance** Follow IEC 61439-3 for panel design and NEC or local electrical codes for service sizing and breaker selection. Ensure selective coord...
