

Has the price of optical fiber increased this year



AI Overview

Global optical fiber prices have surged dramatically in early 2026 due to unprecedented demand from AI data centers, military drone applications, and supply chain constraints. Current Price Levels As of early 2026, G.657A1 fiber is trading around \$22 per kilometer, while G.657A2 fiber has reached \$35 per kilometer, representing increases of approximately 80–90% compared to mid-2025 levels. Standard single-mode G.652D fiber has also risen 45–70% since Q3 2025, with spot market prices in some regions doubling. Lead times have extended from 4–6 weeks to 12–20 weeks, and inventory levels at major manufacturers are at historic lows.

Key Drivers of the Price Surge

- 1. Explosive Demand from AI and Data Centers:** The rapid expansion of AI clusters and generative AI workloads requires ultra-high-bandwidth, low-latency optical interconnects within and between data centers. Hyperscalers like AWS, Google, Microsoft, and Meta are building inter-data-center backbone networks at unprecedented scale, driving massive fiber consumption.
- 2. Military and Specialized Applications:** Widespread use of fiber-guided loitering munitions and FPV drones in conflicts, particularly in Eastern Europe and the Middle East, has created additional demand for high-performance fibers, especially G.657A1 and G.657A2 grades.
- 3. Supply-Side Constraints:** Preform availability is tight, limiting fiber production capacity. High energy costs for fiber drawing (melting preforms at ~2000°C) have increased production expenses. Geopolitical factors such as US tariffs on Chinese fiber and environmental regulations in China have reduced output from major producers. Logistics bottlenecks and specialized packaging requirements add 3–5 weeks to delivery times.
