

Home Fiber Optic Panel Wiring

- Fiber Panel Termination:** If using a fiber panel, route the fiber from the ONT to the panel. Terminate fibers using LC or SC connectors, and organize them with patch cords to distribute to different rooms or devices ().
- Internal Network Wiring:** Use Cat6 or Cat6a Ethernet cables to connect the ONT or fiber panel to your router, switches, or other network devices. This ensures high-speed connectivity throughout the home ().
- Testing and Verification:** After wiring, test each connection for signal integrity and speed. Ensure all devices are online and the network is stable ().
