Sealing: Apply duct seal around conduits entering the panel to block humid air, but avoid general-purpose sealants . Rust treatment: Minor exterior rust can be removed, primed, and painted with metal-specific paint, avoiding contact with breakers or wiring . Replacement Considerations If the panel is heavily rusted, metal is eaten through, or internal components are corroded, replacement is often the safest option . Corrosion inside the panel, especially on breakers, bus bars, or lugs, is a red flag that professional intervention is required to prevent fire hazards .
