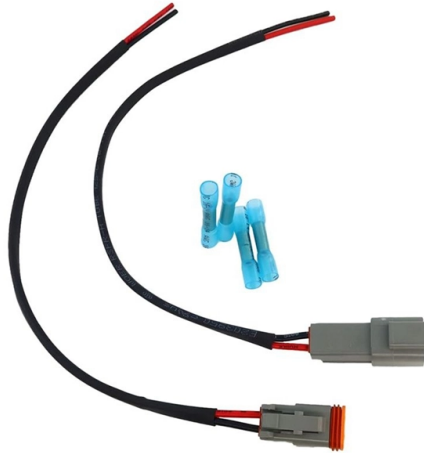


Horizontal cable tray cover plate fixing method

- Ensure the tray and cover are manufactured according to standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable tray systems, which ensures mechanical strength and safety.
- Use appropriate mounting supports like wall-mounted brackets, ceiling-mounted rods, or floor-mounted bases to maintain tray alignment and prevent sagging.
- Verify that the cover plate can withstand environmental and mechanical loads, including the weight of cables, wind, or vibration.
- Always follow safety guidelines and use tools suitable for the fixing method chosen, ensuring screws, clamps, or buckles are tightened properly to prev...
