Overview

The main electrical panel, commonly called the breaker box, is the central distribution point for all power inside the home. The main service disconnect feeds the panel's two main bus bars, which carry the two 120-volt “hot” legs of power. Standard household circuits operate at 120 volts by drawing. Most homes have three-wire service—two hot wires and one neutral. Electric power distribution is the final stage in the delivery of electricity. Electricity is carried from the transmission system to individual consumers. Distribution substations connect to the transmission system and lower the transmission voltage to medium voltage ranging between 2 kV and 33 kV with the use of transformers. Primary distribution lines carry this medium voltage power to distribution transformers located
