

How are fiber optic connectors manufactured

Polishing – The ferrule tip is polished to remove imperfections and achieve a smooth, flat, or angled surface depending on the connector type (e.g., PC, UPC, APC). This step is critical for minimizing insertion loss and back reflection.

Assembly – The ferrule is inserted into the connector housing, and the crimp sleeve is applied to secure the cable's strength members. The housing is then closed, ensuring the fiber remains aligned and protected.

Testing and Quality Control – Each connector is tested for insertion loss, return loss, and mechanical strength to ensure it meets industry standards.
