Rebar couplers reduce labor and material costs compared to traditional lap splicing. Pot bearings accommodate large rotations and heavy loads, enhancing durability under harsh conditions. These technologies have been applied in projects such as the Nairobi Expressway, Mbogolo Bridge, and Mtwapa Market Bridges, demonstrating improved efficiency, safety, and sustainability.

Standards and Regulations Bridge construction in Kenya follows standard specifications set by government agencies such as the Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) and the Kenya National Highways Authority (KeNHA). These specifications provide technical guidelines for materials, design, and construction methods, ensuring safety, durability, and compliance with modern engineering practices.
