

How many circuits should be left in a home electrical distribution box

- Bathrooms:** One 20-amp circuit for receptacles near sinks; may also power lighting and ventilation if serving a single bathroom
- Major appliances:** Electric ranges (50A, 240V), dryers (30A, 240V), water heaters, HVAC units, and other high-load devices each require their own dedicated circuits

General-Purpose Circuits General lighting and standard outlets throughout living spaces (bedrooms, living rooms, hallways) are served by general-purpose branch circuits. The number of these circuits is calculated based on the total lighting load, typically 3 VA per square foot, divided by the capacity of a standard 15- or 20-amp circuit.

Panel Capacity and Future-Proofing

Panel size: Most modern homes use a 200A service with a 42-space panel, which accommodates current needs and allows for 15-20% spare capacity for future additions like EV chargers, workshops, or home offices.

Minimum panel spaces: Never install fewer than 30 spaces, as this limits flexibility and future expansion.
