Network Type: 5G RRUs generally require faster modules than 4G RRUs. Fiber Resource Optimization: CWDM or WDM solutions can reduce the number of physical fibers while maintaining multiple channels. In summary, one RRU typically contains 2 to 6 optical modules in 4G networks, while 5G RRUs may use multiple 25G modules depending on the number of antennas and required throughput, with the exact number varying by manufacturer and deployment scenario.
