

How many units are needed for the distribution box

The number of units (or module spaces) needed for a distribution box depends on the total number of circuits and devices you plan to install, typically measured in TE (17.5 mm per module). Understanding Units in a Distribution Box Distribution boxes are designed to house circuit breakers, fuses, RCDs, and other protective devices. Sum the total TE required: Add the TE for all devices to get the total number of units needed.

Include spare capacity: It is recommended to leave 20–30% extra space for future expansion or additional circuits.

Example

If a home has:

- 10 lighting circuits (1 TE each) = 10 TE
- 5 outlet circuits (1 TE each) = 5 TE
- 1 water heater (2 TE) = 2 TE
- 1 RCD (4 TE) = 4 TE

Total TE required = 10 + 5 + 2 + 4 = 21 TE.

Choosing a distribution box with at least 24–30 TE would allow for future expansion and safe installation.

Additional Considerations

Environment: Indoor vs. outdoor installation may require boxes with higher IP/NEMA ratings.

Load capacity: Ensure the main switch and bus bars can handle the total current demand.

Type of power supply: Single-phase for residential or three-phase for commercial/industrial applications.

Material and durability: Steel or polycarbonate enclosures depending on exposure and mechanical requirements.
