

How much wire should be stripped from the fiber optic cable for splicing



Overview

An optical fiber stripper is designed to remove these buffer and acrylate coatings, typically from a 250 μ m or 900 μ m diameter down to the 125 μ m cladding. This process is a critical prerequisite for both fusion splicing and connector termination. Properly stripping the cable and preparing the fibre ends ensures a clean and secure connection, leading to optimal signal transmission and network performance.
