

How should cables be laid in cable trays

For long runs or expansion joints, use expansion connectors and install bonding jumpers to maintain electrical continuity. Ground cable trays at least every 15 meters and at both ends for safety.

Cable Handling and Maintenance Handle cables carefully to prevent insulation damage during installation. Fix cables at regular intervals using ties or clamps, but avoid over-tightening. Ensure joints are properly insulated and routed to prevent mechanical stress. Plan for future maintenance by leaving enough space for adding or removing cables without disturbing existing ones.
