5. Labeling and Documentation Clearly label each circuit and wire to facilitate maintenance, troubleshooting, and future upgrades. Maintain a record of the wiring layout and breaker assignments for reference.
6. Safety Checks After wiring, perform insulation resistance tests and verify circuit continuity with a multimeter. Ensure all breakers and fuses are correctly rated for t...
