

How thick is the base plate of the cable tray

Duty Class and Load

- Light duty:** Small cables, short spans; 1.5–2 mm steel base plate.
- Medium duty:** Moderate cable load; 2–3 mm steel base plate.
- Heavy duty:** Large power cables or long spans; 4–6 mm steel base plate.
