Understand the Purpose A distribution box (also called a consumer unit, electrical panel, or load center) is the central hub of your home's electrical system. Determine Electrical Load and Size Calculate total load: Add up the amperage of all major appliances and lighting circuits, then add 25% for safety (the "125% rule") to account for peak usage.

Select amperage: Modern homes typically require 200A, while older or smaller homes may use 60A-100A. Large homes with EV chargers or HVAC systems may need 400A or multiple panels.

Future-proofing: Choose a panel with extra slots ("ways") for future circuits, such as EV chargers or solar panels.

Choose the Type of Circuit Breakers

- 1P (Single Pole):** Controls only the live wire, suitable for simple circuits.
- 1P+N (Single Pole + Neutral):** Protects both live and neutral wires.
- 2P (Double Pole):** Provides full isolation for live and neutral wires, ideal for high-safety circuits.

Additional protections: Include RCBOs, RCDs, surge protection devices, and overvoltage/undervoltage protectors for enhanced safety.

Material and Environmental Considerations

Enclosure material: Cold-rolled steel ($\geq 1.2\text{mm}$) or flame-retardant ABS plastic ensures durability and fire resistance.

IP rating: IP40 is sufficient for general indoor use; IP54 or IP65 is recommended for humid or outdoor environments.

UV and heat resistance: For outdoor installations, choose materials resistant to UV light and high temperatures.
