

How to check the GB s of an optical module

The “size” of an optical module is typically its data rate, such as 1G or 10G, which can be checked via the module label, model number, or network device interface.

Physical Inspection

These commands display the module's speed, vendor, and other diagnostic information.

Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM): Many MSA-compliant modules store speed and vendor information in internal memory. Reading DDM data via the switch interface provides accurate identification without removing the module.

Vendor-Specific Commands

Huawei: Use `display transceiver [interface | slot]` to view detailed optical module information, including speed, wavelength, and transmission distance.

Summary

To determine the “size” of an optical module in terms of bandwidth:

- Start with physical inspection of the label and model number.
- If installed, use network device CLI commands or DDM to confirm the speed.
- Refer to vendor documentation for detailed specifications and compatibility.
