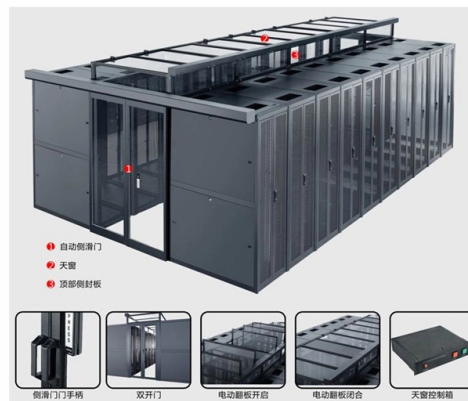


How to coil fiber optic cable connectors and reels

Coiling Fiber Optic Connectors

- Special cases:** For unusually long or short fibers, coil them separately at the end to maintain neatness and prevent tangling.
- Tidy layout:** Ensure fibers are coiled neatly to avoid “bird's-nest” tangles, which complicate maintenance and increase the risk of damage.

- Reel selection:** Choose reels made of wood, metal, or plastic with appropriate drum diameter and flange design to prevent bending or twisting.

- Proper winding:** Wind the cable evenly on the drum, avoiding crossovers or kinks. Inspect the reel for damage before use.
- Deployment:** When unspooling, maintain a smooth, controlled pull to prevent crushing or sharp bends. For vertical installations, clamp the cable at intervals to support its weight and prevent long-term stress.
