- 3. Using a Coupler (Adapter)** A coupler or adapter connects two pre-terminated fiber optic cables by aligning their ferrules with a zirconia sleeve. This method is the simplest and fastest, requiring no splicing tools. It is suitable for patch panels, short-term connections, or when connecting standard connectors like LC, SC, or ST.

- Connector Type Compatibility:** Ensure both connectors are of the same type (e.g., LC to LC, SC to SC) and match the fiber mode (single-mode or multimode) to prevent signal degradation.
- Cleaning and Inspection:** Always clean fiber ends with specialized tools and inspect for dust, scratches, or debris, as even minor contamination can cause significant signal loss.
- Proper Alignment:** The ferrules and fiber cores must be precisely aligned to minimize reflection and insertion loss.
