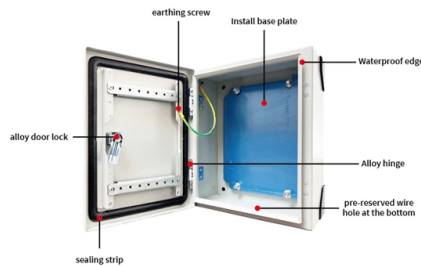


# How to connect a fiber optic switch to the network
