

How to connect an OLT to a primary beam splitter

4. Distribute to Outputs: The primary splitter will divide the optical signal into multiple outputs. These outputs can either: Connect directly to ONTs in a centralized splitting architecture, or Feed into secondary splitters in a cascaded configuration for larger networks.
5. Test and Verify: After connection, verify optical power levels at the splitter outputs to ensure signal quality. Adjust the split ratio or fiber routing if necessary to maintain adequate signal strength for all subscribers.

- Centralized vs. Cascaded Splitting: Centralized splitters are placed near the OLT and reduce fiber count, while cascaded splitters allow flexible distribution in dispersed areas.
- Splitter Orientation: For cube or plate beam splitters, ensure the light enters the correct surface to avoid reflection losses.
