 - Angle Plates (L, T, or Cross):** Used to join trays at corners or junctions, allowing cables to change direction without compromising support.
- Installation Steps:
 - Inspect trays for damage and verify dimensions against approved drawings.
 - Align tray sections carefully to maintain level and straight runs.
 - Secure connections using the chosen method, ensuring all bolts are tightened to manufacturer specifications.
 - Install supports and brackets at recommended intervals (typically 1.5–3 meters) to prevent sagging.
 - Label each tray section for feeder identification and future maintenance.

Connecting Cable Conduits to Trays

- Use Proper Fittings:
 - Conduit Adapters or Reducers:** Connect conduits to tray entry points, ensuring a smooth transition for cables.
 - Conduit Clamps:** Secure conduits to tray sides or supports to prevent movement and maintain alignment.
- Grounding and Bonding:
 - Ensure all trays and conduits are properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards. Use bonding jumpers or grounding lugs as required by code.
