

How to connect fiber optic cable to pigtail

Insert the fibers into a mechanical splice sleeve, which aligns and holds them together using index-matching gel or adhesive. This method is less permanent but faster for field installations.

Protect the Splice

Slide a protective sleeve over the splice and heat-shrink it if using fusion splicing. Place the splice into a splice tray or enclosure to prevent damage and maintain fiber integrity.

Testing

Use an optical power meter or OTDR to verify the splice quality and ensure minimal signal loss. Confirm that the connector end of the pigtail properly interfaces with the equipment or patch panel.
