

How to connect the fiber optic cable test cable connector

Step 4: Connect to Test Equipment For insertion loss or continuity testing, connect the test cable to the light source and the other end to the power meter or optical loss test set (OLTS) (). If using a reference test cable, first measure the power output to establish a baseline, then connect the cable under test to compare readings ().

Step 5: Verify the Connection Perform a single-ended test to check one connector at a time or a double-ended test for installed cable plants (). Use a visual fault locator (VFL) to confirm continuity and detect breaks or bends in the fiber ().

Step 6: Manage and Protect the Cable Avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius and prevent tension on the cable. Use cable managers or Velcro straps to secure excess cable and prevent misalignment or damage (). By following these steps, you ensure that the fiber opti...
