

How to connect the pigtail cable of a fiber optic patch cord

Step 5: Test the Connection Use a fiber optic power meter or OTDR (Optical Time Domain Reflectometer) to measure splice loss and verify the connection quality. Confirm that the splice loss is within acceptable limits to ensure optimal network performance.

Key Tips Always order slightly longer pigtails than needed to allow for adjustments during splicing. Keep the work area clean and handle fibers carefully to prevent micro-ben...
