

How to connect two fiber optic patch cables

- Match Fiber Type:** Ensure the patch cable matches the fiber type of the connected cables—single-mode for long distances and multi-mode for short distances within data centers.
- Check Connector Compatibility:** Patch cables come with various connectors such as LC, SC, ST, or MPO/MTP. The connectors must match the adapters on both fiber ends. Avoid mixing APC and UPC finishes, as this can cause reflection and signal loss.
- Maintain Proper Polarity:** Fiber patch cables are often twisted internally to maintain correct transmit (TX) to receive (RX) alignment. Ensure the patch cable polarity is correct to prevent TX-to-TX or RX-to-RX misalignment.
- Clean Connectors:** Always clean the connectors with lint-free wipes or fiber cleaning tools before insertion to prevent dust or oil contamination, which can degrade signal quality.
