- Quick Connect Systems:** Snap, slide, or twist mechanisms allow fast assembly with minimal tools. These are ideal for large projects where speed is important but may be brand-specific.
- Angle Plates (L, T, or Cross Plates):** Used to join trays at corners or junctions, allowing smooth routing around obstacles.
- Clamps and Fish Plates:** Secure trays and covers, prevent sagging, and allow easy disassembly for maintenance.

Ensure alignment and level installation. Supports such as wall brackets, trapeze hangers, or center-span supports should be spaced according to tray type and load, typically 1.5–3 meters apart.
