Flip one end of the duplex cable 180° to correct polarity and restore connectivity.

Step 6: Test Signal Strength Use an Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) or a power meter to measure signal loss. Values outside the typical range (e.g., -15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate attenuation or damage along the fiber. Replace or repair the affected section as needed.

Step 7: Restart Devices Reboot the switch, connected routers, or media converters to resolve temporary glitches. Check indicator LEDs for status; a “LOS” (Loss of Signal) light indicates connectivity issues...
