

# How to identify network cables in a distribution box

**Continuity Testing with an Ohmmeter** For a more manual approach, you can use an ohmmeter. Twist together a pair of conductors at one end of the cable, then measure resistance at the other end. The cable showing no resistance corresponds to the twisted pair you connected, allowing you to identify the correct cable. Remember to untwist the conductors after testing.

**Labeling for Future Reference** Once identified, label each cable clearly to simplify future maintenance. Use printed labels rather than handwritten ones for clarity and durability. Include information such as the distribution box ID, cable number, and destination. A logical numbering system helps maintain organization and prevents confusion during troubleshooting or network changes.

**Additional Tips** Keep a record of cable IDs and destinations in a network diagram or spreadsheet. If multiple cables are running to the same room, test each individually to avoid misidentification. For large installations, consider using a netwo...
