

How to install a router connected to fiber optic cable

- Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1).
- Enter your ISP-provided credentials to authenticate the connection.
- Update the router firmware if necessary and configure Wi-Fi settings, including network name (SSID) and password.
- Optionally, enable Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize traffic for streaming or gaming.

Step 5: Verify the Connection

- Check that devices can access the internet through the router.
- Confirm that the ONT and router lights indicate a stable connection.

Safety and Best Practices

- Always turn off the router before connecting cables.
- Avoid bending the fiber optic cable sharply to prevent damage.

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
