Wire Selection: Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current.

Organization: Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear labeling of circuits for future maintenance.

Protection Devices: Equip each circuit with breakers, fuses, or Residual Current Devices (RCDs/RCBOs) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and leakage.

Safety and Grounding

Grounding: The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded.

Leakage Protection: Install a leakage protection device (RCD) for circuits where leakage protection is required.
