

How to install pigtail sleeves

- 4. Apply Heat-Shrink Protection:** Slide heat-shrink tubing over the joint and use a heat gun to shrink it. This seals the connection against moisture and mechanical stress. For adhesive-lined tubing, ensure the adhesive melts to create a watertight seal ().
- 5. Test the Connection:** Use a multimeter or test light to verify continuity and proper electrical function. Perform a pull test to ensure the crimped or soldered joint is mechanically secure ().
- 6. Final Touches:** Optionally, wrap the wire bundle with self-fusing silicone tape for a polished finish, especially in shielded or high-vibration applications ().
