Step 4: Splicing and Termination Strip the protective jacket from the fiber using a fiber jacket stripping tool, clean the fibers with 99% isopropyl alcohol and lint-free wipes, and cleave them precisely at 90 degrees using a high-quality cleaver. Perform fusion splicing to connect incoming fibers to pigtails or adapters inside the box. Ensure splices are properly protected in splice trays to prevent stress or contamination.
